

Acadian Entomological Society Insect Collecting Trip

Where: McNabs Island, Halifax

When: June 10, 1:00-4:00 pm

What: Wear good boots, bring your own collecting equipment and fly dope.

Starting point: Fisherman's Cove, Eastern Passage, NS

We will meet gather in the Fisherman's Cove parking lot near the Subway restaurant at 12:30 noon. You will need to arrange your own transportation to Fisherman's Cove from Saint Mary's. Suzie has emailed a map with directions. Once we know who is going, we can arrange some car-pooling.

Round-trip boat ride to the Island will cost \$12.00 per person or less, depending on the numbers participating, e.g., if we have 15 people, it will only be \$10 per person.

Jeff Ogden has kindly offered to lead the collecting trip and provide some tools for collecting. I will give a brief tour and explanation of some of the field trapping experiments on *Tetropium* spp. pheromones set up on the Island this year.
